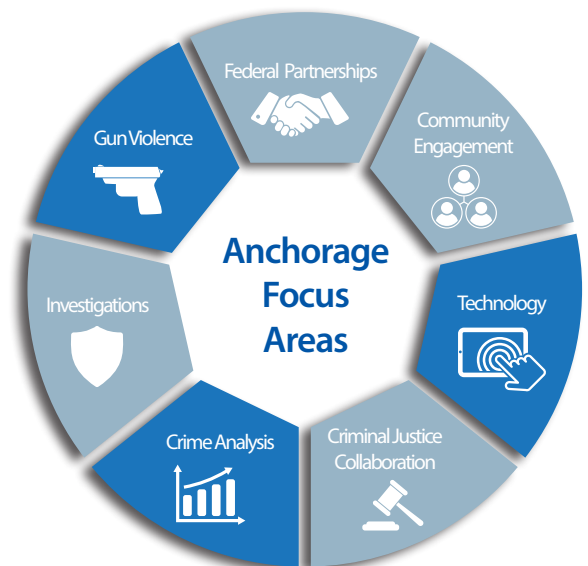


## PSP Successes
