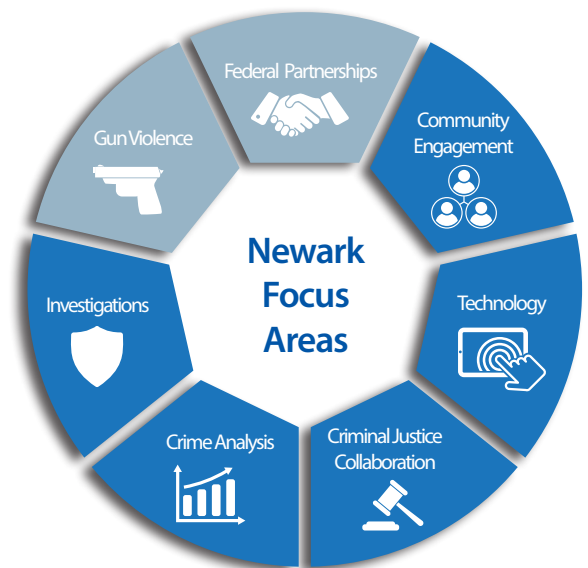


PSP Successes
